Actions / Initiatives to Maintain


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| 1 - | School-wide Activities Against Homophobia is held during the year and reinforced throughout the year |

Actions / Initiatives to Develop

We will continue to work on using MIndfulness and incorporating it into the classroom routine. We used the Kind Kids program for our pre-k to grade 2 students. This program should be continued for he next school year.

We took part in the Our School Survey 2 times this year. The first was November and the second was in June. Some improvements were made, but we still need to work on the anxiety felt by students. We need to explore why the students show an increase in the bullying and exclusion despite the programs in place.



The data from Lumix indicated that there were 56 incidences of serious violence and no incidences of bullying. The number s of violence were greater because there were 2 people inputting the data so more incidences were recorded. All incidences were reported – from a kick to a fight. We plan to reduce these numbers by 5% for 2021-2022 using all the strategies listed above.
