

Mountainview Elementary Educational Project REPORT: 2021

*The Educational Project is a strategic tool through which an educational institution can define its policy orientations, priority actions and expected results and inform its community in this regard, with a view to ensuring educational success for all students regardless of age. The educational project reflects the characteristics and needs of the students who attend the educational institution, as well as the community's expectations with regard to education.**

The SWLSB Council of Commissioners approved our Commitment to Success Plan in October 2018, which was subsequently approved by the Ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur in November 2018. To be aligned with this plan, Mountainview Elementary School developed our Educational Project which was adopted by Mountainview's Governing Board on June 10, 2019. As did all schools in Quebec, we began implementation of this project during the 2019-2020 school year.

Below is a list of Educational Project Objectives and Orientations established by our school community:

MEQ Objective 1 By 2030, reduce to the gap in success rates between various groups of students by 50%	
MEQ Objective 3 By 2030, have 85% of students under the age of 20 obtain a first diploma (SSD or DVS), and 90% obtain a first diploma or qualification.	
MEQ Objective 4 By 2030, increase to 90% the success rate on the composition component of the Elementary 6 (Cycle 3, Year 2) language of instruction ministerial examination in the public system.	

MEQ Orientation 1: Increase the level of literacy competencies among the adult population on the school board territory
MEQ Orientation 2: Elementary school students will engage in physical activity (60 minutes a day for elementary school students)

SWLSB Orientation 1: Increase the level of literacy competencies among the adult population on the school board territory
SWLSB Orientation 2: Elementary school students will engage in physical activity (60 minutes a day for elementary school students)

SWLSB Orientation 3: Developing and implementing curriculum, programs and educational initiatives that provide authentic learning experiences and promote student engagement


Mountainview Orientation 1: Support high quality teaching practices
