Book Fair

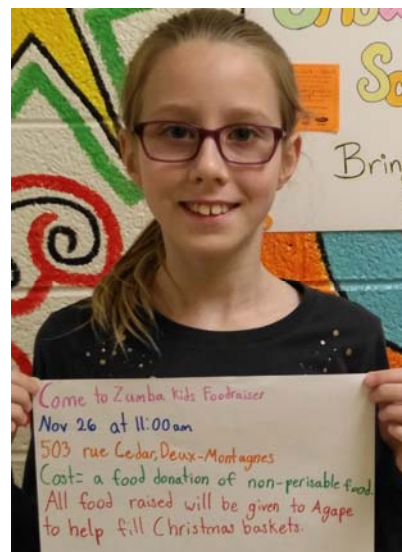
